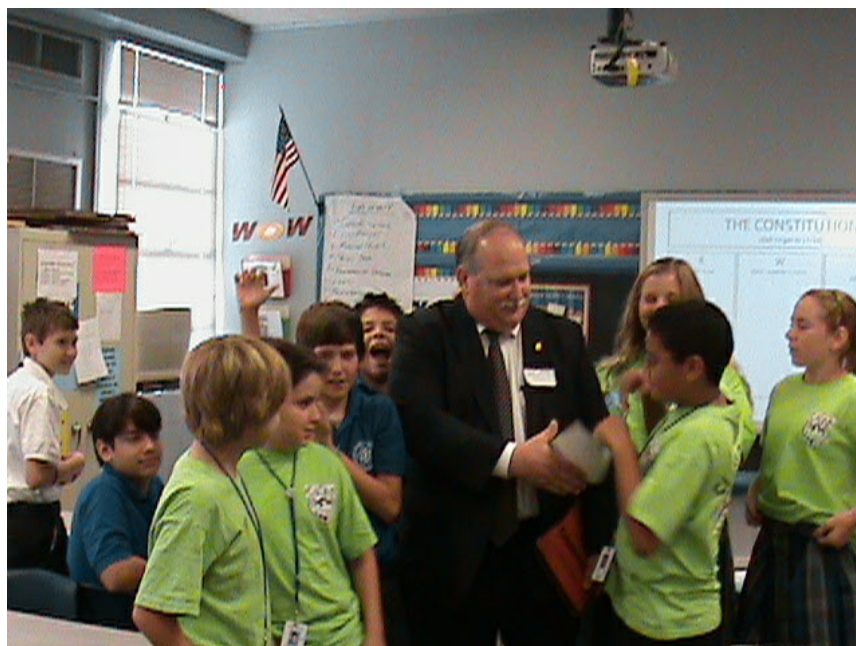
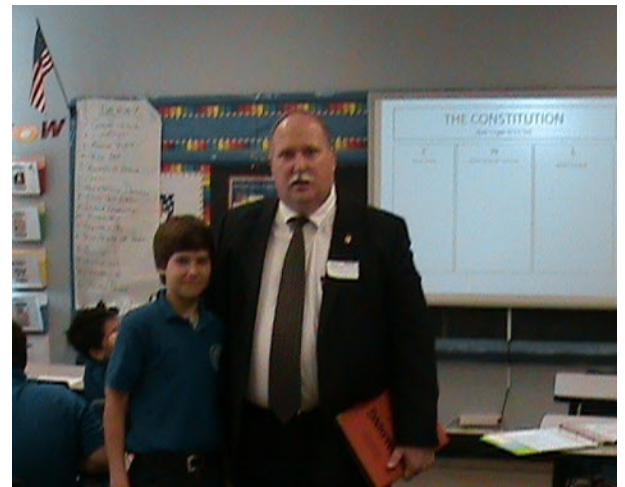


Lions In Actions
